A central hub championing innovative photography publishing, this specialised bookstore has acquired a phenomenal selection of photo books, artist books, independent publications, rare editions and prints since its opening in 2011, with releases from MACK, Steidl, AKINA and kameraphoto amongst its extensive inventory. The store also stages events and launches for domestic and international publishers, whilst also heading up EDIT – a new summer book fair showcasing the work of 30 handpicked publishers and authors.
